There are other Medici's in Paterson, NJ from Polla, Italy including another Angelo born circa 1882. They were most likely cousins because this Angelo did not have any brothers. The fact that there was another Angelo Medici in Paterson may be why the name Marrich was used.

1940 Census shows Mary a widow living at 305 Preakness Ave Paterson, NJ so Angelo died before 1940.

There's a grave marker in Holy Sepulchre Cemetary in Totowa, NJ for Angelo Medici who died 1934. Don't know if this is the same Angelo
