2. Grandfather Robert Patrick Tyrrell was born on 15 Dec 1890 in Glasgow, Hutchinson, Lanarkshire County, Scotland and died in Apr 1964 in New York at age 73. Other names for Robert were Patrick Tyrrell and Robert Joseph Tyrrell.

General Notes: The ship manifest for when he immigrated shows his birth year as 1892. The 1930 US Census has it as 1896. The date used is from his WW I registration which he signed. 1930 census shows his occupation as a plumber for the Grand Central Railroad. The WW I registration shows the same thing. The ship manifest lists him as Patrick but the 1930 census shows Robert. The WW I registration shows his name as Robert Joseph and the WW II registration shows his name as Robert Patrick. The dob for the draft registrations match.

Birth records for Hutchesontown Glasgow Scotland were searched up to 1900 but no record of Robert Tyrrell's birth was found.

1930 Census shows Patrick and Anna Tryrell living at 279 Washington Street Bronx, NY. Living there are sons Joseph, Thomas and Charles so I don't think this is the same Patrick Tyrrell.

My grandmother, Margaret Scott Straiton Tyrrell, died of cancer at the ripe old age of 46 in 1940; I was 2 years old. We lived in Yonkers, thereafter, moved to Parkchester along with my Aunt Fran who was ten years older than me. My grandfather moved there also and had an apartment in the next bldg.

Death record for William Straiton who died 19 Jul 1919 shows DOB 1862, father John, mother Margaret with maiden name Scott (deceased). See notes for Mary McBride. I don't think this the same William.

General Notes: The burial record record for William Tyrrell listed a Monica Sherry, a niece, as providing the information. There is a record of a Monica Tyrrell marrying a James Sherry on the same day a Patrick Tyrrell married an Ellen Sherry. It appears a brother and sister married a brother and sister. However their ages suggest they were born early 1840s and a search of online records so far digitized shows twins Patrick and Monica Tyrrell born 1833. These families appear to be in Dublin after 1900. However, because of doubt with their births, a search continued on Rathmines Parish Register (south of Goldenbridgeand not digitized) but very few Tyrrells were listed per its index. Further research would need to be conducted.

NY shows a death record for William Tyrrell wife Anna DaVerne and daughter Francis. There's no date and there's no other information to suggest that William came to NY and died there.

At plot 3 were 'ruins' but a house and garden was included about Sept 1863 with 'lodgers but by Oct 1868 a Richd Reilly became the occupier.

Barrack Street (from Naas Road) - At Plot 7-no.3, a William Tyrrell was included as the occupier of the house and yard

with Catherine Callaghan possibly about Oct 1875

Barrack Street (from Naas Road) - At Plot 7-no.3 both William Tyrrell and Catherine Callaghan were crossed off about

Byrnes Cottages were now 'off Thomas Davies Street' and 1 to 4 renamed Quinn's Cottages

At Plot 7-no.3 Richard Reilly was crossed off about 1885 and James Lynch inserted.

Colton Street became part of Thomas Davies Street.

Plot 7-no.17a the house valued at £2 was vacant but a Michl Sproule became occupier but crossed off and a William Tyrrell inserted in the 1880s. The latter was also crossed off and house became vacant

Plot 22 Coulton Street South now Thomas Davies Street a Peter Tyrrell became occupier for a while in the 1880s Barrack St (from Naas Road) became St Vincent's St.

Plot 7-no.3 the lodgers were replaced by Laurence Kelly

Plot 7-no.11 a John and Joseph Sproule were occupier for a while but later moved to House 12

Golden Bridge North Townland (1880-1900), 2nd Revision

Plot 4 later changed to Plot 12 North Side Thomas Davies St.- Occupied from about 1892 by a Christopher Tyrrell (A

Henry Sproule had been occupier there for a while)

St Vincent's St Plot 12 Joseph and John Sproule were crossed off about 1892
