First Generation

1. G2 Great Grandfather William Tyrrell was born circa 1827 in Inchicore, Ireland and died on 28 Sep 1887 in Goldenbridge (Dublin), Ireland about age 60.

General Notes: The burial record record for William Tyrrell listed a Monica Sherry, a niece, as providing the information. There is a record of a Monica Tyrrell marrying a James Sherry on the same day a Patrick Tyrrell married an Ellen Sherry. It appears a brother and sister married a brother and sister. However their ages suggest they were born early 1840s and a search of online records so far digitized shows twins Patrick and Monica Tyrrell born 1833. These families appear to be in Dublin after 1900. However, because of doubt with their births, a search continued on Rathmines Parish Register (south of Goldenbridgeand not digitized) but very few Tyrrells were listed per its index. Further research would need to be conducted.

NY shows a death record for William Tyrrell wife Anna DaVerne and daughter Francis. There's no date and there's no other information to suggest that William came to NY and died there.

William married **Margaret Rourke** on 5 Sep 1853 in Finglas, Ireland. Margaret was born circa 1827 in Ireland and died on 31 Jan 1875 in Goldenbridge (Dublin), Ireland about age 48. The cause of her death was Cancer of Uterus. Another name for Margaret was Margaret O'Rourke and O'Reilly.

Marriage Notes: William Tyrrell to Margaret O'Reilly in Finglas Roman Catholic Parish, the bride's maid was Monica Tyrrell. It's possible that O'Reilly was transcribed incorrectly. A Monica Tyrrell immigrated to New York in 1880 and lived with Frances Tyrrell

The dob used is from the census.

General Notes: The ship manifest for when he immigrated shows his birth year as 1892. The 1930 US Census has it as 1896. The date used is from his WW I registration which he signed. 1930 census shows his occupation as a plumber for the Grand Central Railroad. The WW I registration shows the same thing. The ship manifest lists him as Patrick but the 1930 census shows Robert. The WW I registration shows his name as Robert Joseph and the WW II registration shows his name as Robert Patrick. The dob for the draft registrations match.

Birth records for Hutchesontown Glasgow Scotland were searched up to 1900 but no record of Robert Tyrrell's birth was found.

From Mary Jane Feurbacker. "My grandfather moved there (Parkchester, NY) also and had an apartment in the next bldg.

He remarried a Scottish lady named Sally (in '50's). When she died they'd had parties singing the bar song, "I wonder what became of Sally" Our Scottish sense of humor."

1930 Census shows Patrick and Anna Tryrell living at 279 Washington Street Bronx, NY. Living there are sons Joseph, Thomas and Charles so it's unlikely this is the same Patrick Tyrrell.

20. William T. Quinn (Elizabeth Margaret Tyrrell ³, Patrick (Great Grandfather) ², William (G2 Great Grandfather) ¹) was born on 6 May 1912 in Manhattan, NY and died on 29 Apr 1994 in Carmrillo, CA at age 81.

General Notes: 1920 census shows him immigrating before he was born.

One of the most familiar faces on TV in the 1960s, 1970s and 1980s, he was often seen as a bartender, judge, father, sheriff or military officer. Tall, thin and bald, with a skull-like face, deep-set eyes and a sort of half-smile he was probably best known as a TV actor although he appeared in some classic films. He was born on May 6, 1912 in New York City and made his acting debut at age 2 in the Broadway production "Daddies." He made his film debut in 1918 at the age of 6 as Billy Quinn and a few films as child star including "The New School Teacher" (1924) as Pupil. He didn't appear in another film until 36 years later. He worked in all facets of show business including vaudeville, theatre, radio, films and television. He had a successful Broadway career and appeared in "The Bluebird", "That Smith Boy" and "Winterset." On radio he performed on such programs as "Just Plain Bill", "Mrs. Wiggs of the Cabbage Patch" and "Front Page Farrell." His film credits include: "Mountain Road" (1960) as Col. Magnusson, his film debut; "From the Terrace" (1960) as Lawrence Von Elm; "Advise and Consent" (1962) as Sen. Paul Hendershot; Hitchcock's "The Birds" (1963) as Man in Diner; "Dark Intruder" (1965) as Neighbor; "Love is a Funny Thing" (1969) as Passenger; "How to Frame a Figg" (1971) as Carmoni; "Ace Eli and Rodger of the Skies" (1973) as Mortician; "Psychic Killer" (1975) as Hospital Coroner; "Matilda" (1978) as Donohue; "Bustin' Loose" (1981) as Judge Antonio Runzuli; "Dead & Buried" (1981) as Ernie; "Twilight Zone: The Movie" (1983) as Mr. Conroy; "Lucky Stiff" (1988) as Emmet Kassler and "Star Trek VI: The Final Frontier" (1989) as David McCov, Dr. McCov's Father, his final theatrical film. On TV he was a regular on the series: "The Rifleman" (1958-63) as Sweeney the Bartender; "Please Don't Eat the Daisies" (1966-67) as Dean Gerald Carter; "McHale's Navy" (1962-66) as Admiral Benson; "The Mary Tyler Moore Show" (1970-77) as Walter Richards, Mary's Father; "Odd Couple" (1970-75) as Dr. Melnitz; "McMillan and Wife" (1976-77) as Chief Paulson; "Captains and the Kings" (1976) a mini-series, as Dr. Harris Herbert; "All in the Family" [aka "Archie Bunker's Place"] (1978-83) as Mr. Van Ranseleer; "Backstairs at the White House" (1979) a mini-series and "Scruples" (1980) a mini-series, as Judge Riddle. He appeared in many TV movies including: "The Pigeon" (1969); "Satan's School for Girls" (1973); "The Lindbergh Kidnapping Case" (1976); "Tail Gunner Joe" (1977) and "Mysterious Two" (1982). He guest starred on numerous TV series including: "Perry Mason"; "Bonanza"; "Wanted: Dead or Alive"; "Alfred Hitchcock Presents"; "The Beverly Hillbillies"; "The Rogues"; "The Fugitive"; "The Big Valley"; "Bewitched"; "The Bob Newhart Show"; "Little House on the Prairie" and "The Rockford Files." His daughter Virginia married actor Bob Newhart. In fact, Tony Randall, at the wedding, was heard to say, "Look who they got for the father!" He was sometimes billed as William Ouinn. He died on April 29, 1994 of natural causes in Carmarillo, California at age 81.

Robert Tyrrell BERKELEY TWP. - Robert W. Tyrrell, 70, died Tuesday at Community Memorial Hospital in Toms River after a long illness. He was born in the Bronx, N.Y. and lived in Flanders for many years before moving to the Bayville section of the Township three years ago. Mr. Tyrrell was an Army veteran of World War II. He was a cost engineer at Foster Wheeler Corp.'s Fire Heater Division, Livingston where he worked for 35 years before he retired in 1981. He was a former member of St. Therese Roman Catholic Church, Succasunna, and was an avid writer of poetry. Surviving are a son Robert J., with whom he lived; two daughters Johanna Barbieri, Connecticut, and Margaret Alice DeThomas, Hackettstown; two sisters, Frances Ciavolino, Freehold, and Dolores Maloney, Flanders; and five grandchildren.
